

Free Long Distance Telephone Calls Between Phoenix and Tucson!

You can now dial certain long distance numbers free of charge using Toll Bypass:

- Call Phoenix (area codes 602, 480 and 623) free from University phones in Tucson with prefix 621, 626 or 695
- Call Tucson (Pima County area code 520) free of charge from University phones in Phoenix with prefix 827

To use Toll Bypass, simply dial a ten-digit phone number from your University office phone with the prefixes 621, 626, 695 or 827 without using “1” and your call will be completely free with no charge to the department!

If Toll Bypass is not available for any reason, you will hear a fast busy signal when you try to dial the long distance number without the “1”. If you hear the fast busy signal after you dial, re-dial your long distance number in the normal way using the “1” before the ten-digit number. (There will be a toll charge for this type of calling.)

Remember, to use Toll Bypass, DO NOT dial the “1” before the ten-digit telephone number or normal calling charges will be applied.
